One of the most significant events associated with this day is the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. Martyrs'

Day holds immense historical importance, symbolising the spirit of sacrifice and the relentless struggle for independence.

Event Details:

A two-minute silence was observed in honour of all the martyrs who made supreme sacrifices during the freedom struggle.
