Report on Educational Visit to the Department of Forensic Medicine, **RUHS Hospital, Jaipur**

Additionally, students observed pathological analysis conducted as part of postmortem examinations. These real-time observations offered a deep understanding of practical forensic processes, particularly in relation to autopsy procedures and toxicological evaluations. The experience significantly enriched their academic knowledge and provided a clearer perspective on the real-world applications of forensic science. This visit provided the students with practical insights into medico-legal procedures, postmortem examinations, and the working of forensic and pathology labs. It was an eye-opening and
