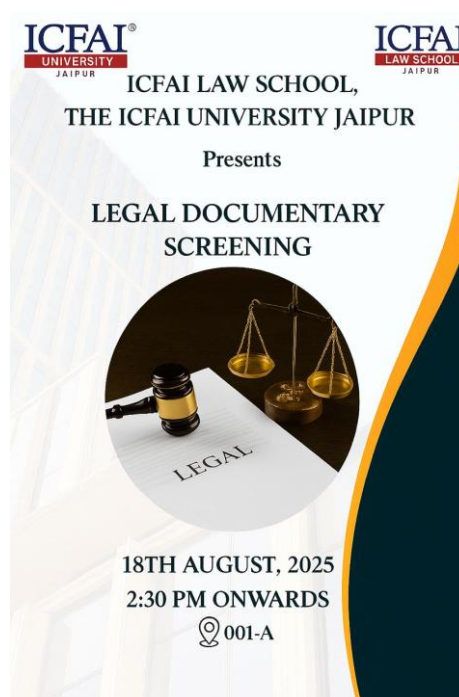


Report on Orientation Programme (Deeksharambh) – Day 4
