**Vision:** The ICFAI University, Jaipur will emerge as a premier center of excellence for career oriented education known for contributing leaders in a vital sector of the state's economy.

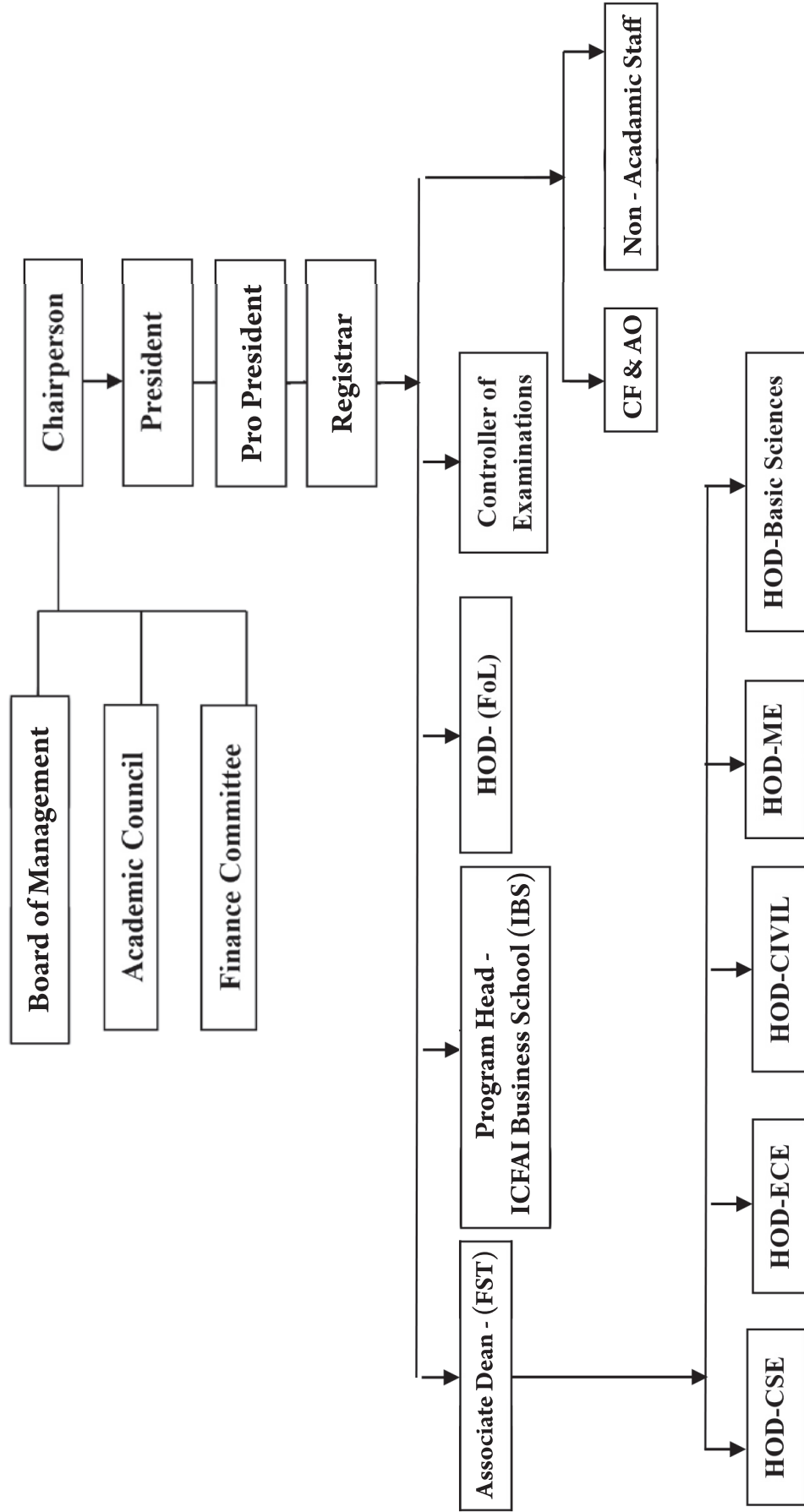

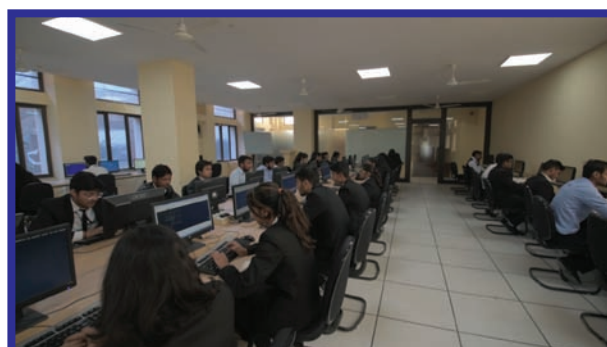
