B. COM (HONS) ADMISSION PROCESS & ELIGIBILITY

In order to get admission in this three-year B. Com (Hons) program at IBS, Jaipur students need to fulfil the following eligibility criteria and admission process:

Eligibility Criteria

Students should pass Class XII (or equivalent) in any discipline with 50% and above aggregate marks. Class XII students awaiting final examination results are also eligible to apply. Final year students applying for the programs are required to complete their examinations including practical examinations/ viva, assignments before August 02, 2021. Such applicants will have to produce a certificate to that effect at the time of admission. The admission of applicants will, however, remain provisional until they produce mark-sheets establishing their eligibility. The last date for submitting the proof of eligibility is September 17, 2021.

Admission Criteria

The selection of applicants into this program is made through a blend of evaluation techniques including merit-based evaluation and personal interviews. While evaluating students for admission, due weightage is given to academic distinction, awards in sports/cultural events, debates, quizzes and other extra/co-curricular activities.
