The expert speakers of the session were Ms. Jyotsana Singh and Mr. Siddharth Sharma, both Mentors at iStart, Rajasthan. The recent past has witnessed a tremendous rise in the number of start-ups in India. The session was organised with the aim to instil and promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship in the students of the university. The dignitaries invited and present on this occasion were Ms. Jyotsana Singh and Mr. Siddharth Sharma, Mentors at iStart, Jaipur, Rajasthan and Prof. (Dr) H P Singh, VSM, Hon'ble President, The ICFAI University, Jaipur.
