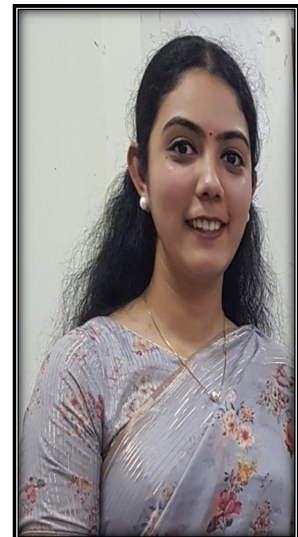


August 21, 2023

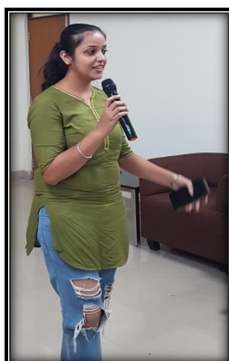

August 24, 2023



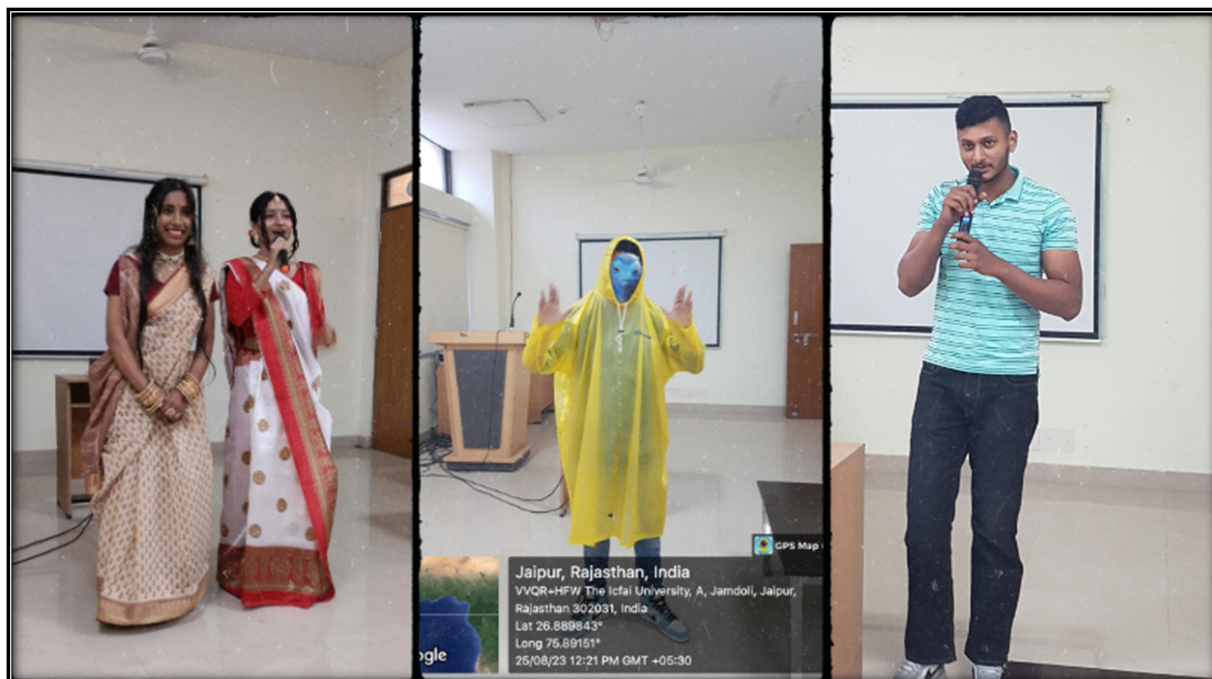
